OSR 2026 Survey

It has been brought to the attention of the Nueces Canyon Chamber of Commerce of an opportunity to increase the number of entrants in the OSR Rodeo if the Chamber were to move OSR to the SECOND WEEKEND in August. Two other rodeos in the area take place the second weekend in August in Sonora and Junction, and capitalizing on this common weekend would allow more entrants to enter all three of these rodeos in proximity to each other.
